#### 249 Michigan St +11

We'll take the better team plus the points. Yes, the Spartans are live in this game, because plain and simple Alabama is not nearly as good as last year (Auburn surely proved that point) and they are living off it's National Championship. Heisman RB Mark Ingram is not close to having the same results and a mediocre SR YR with suffering injuries. Mich St HC Mark Dantonio recruited Mark Ingram and was an assistant coach under Bama HC Nick Saban....motivation indeed. Both teams stop the run well and on offense I'll give the edge to the Spartans who averaged 31.4 points per game. Alabama will be without All-American safety Mark Barron who has a torn pectoral muscle.
